#### Every Day Counts

#### Mobile Phones at School

In accordance with the Department's <u>Mobile Phones Policy</u> issued by the Minister for Education, personal mobile phones must not be used at school during school hours, including lunchtime and recess, unless an exception has been granted. Mobile phones owned by students are considered valuable items and are brought to school at the owner's (student's or parent/carer's) risk. Students are encouraged not to bring a mobile phone to school unless there is a compelling reason to do so. Please note that the school does not have accident insurance for accidental property damage or theft. If students bring a mobile phone to school, they should hand it in to the office when they arrive and it will be securely stored until the end of the school day.

#### Local Excursion Consent Form

Today your child has brought home a local excursion consent form. The purpose of this form is to obtain parent/carer consent for local excursions during 2020. This form does NOT provide consent for excursions that go beyond the local area. Local excursions are excursions to locations within walking distance of the school and do not involve 'Adventure Activities'. Broadford Primary School will NOT seek further consent from you before local excursions take place. However, we will provide advance notice to parents/carers of upcoming local excursions through the school newsletter, class notes and or school Facebook page. #### Canteen News......

Welcome to term 1 of 2020, My name is Hayley and I'm the Canteen Manager here at Broadford Primary School. For new and existing families just a reminder that the canteens days of operation are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Fridays. On these days the canteen is open for students to purchase lunch orders. During recess and lunch breaks snacks and beverages are available for purchase through the canteen window. We ask that when ordering lunch orders that students name, room number and the correct money is written on a brown paper bag and placed into the classroom crates. When providing your child with money to purchase items from the canteen, please ensure that they do not have more then a \$10 note. If a student presents with a note above this amount they will be referred to the office for assistance before returning to the canteen to purchase items. Volunteers are more then welcome to assist in the canteen especially on Friday and special order days. In order to help out you will need a "Volunteer Working With Children" check. Should you require anymore information please see myself or the office.



## **Attendance**

#### Notify the school of your child's absence

Protecting the safety and well-being of children through the reporting and monitoring of absenteeism is the responsibility of both parents/carers and schools.

Please remember to call the school on 57841221 or email at <a href="mailto:broad-ford.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au">broad-ford.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au</a> or log your child's absence using our school's IT platform Compass.

Do this early in the morning if your child is going to be away or late for school so your child's absence can be recorded correctly. For further information on the processes and procedures our school uses to record, monitor and follow-up student attendance and absence please read our Attendance Policy.

#### Same-day notification of unexplained student absences

Our school will text you as soon as practicable on the day if a student is not at school and you haven't notified the school as to why. If you are notified by the school that your child is away without a reason, please contact us as soon as possible by calling 57841221 or email at <a href="mailto:broadford.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au">broadford.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au</a> or log your child's absence using our school's IT platform Compass to let us know where your child is. If we cannot reach you because we don't have your correct contact details (i.e.: message notification fail, disconnected number), then we will make contact with any emergency contact/s nominated on your child's file held by the school, where possible, on the same day of the unexplained absence.

Please remember it is your responsibility to contact us to provide an explanation for your child's absence from school, and where possible, please inform us in advance of upcoming absences.

#### Attendance Requirements

If your child is sick or absent, you are required to notify the school as soon as possible **on the day of absence**, by calling, emailing or online through Compass.

Notifying the school of your child's absence either prior to, or on the day that they will be away, helps ensure the safety and wellbeing of children and will fulfil your legal responsibility.

From the end of Term 2 2018, all Victorian government schools are required to contact parents/carers as soon as practicable on the same day of an unexplained student absence. If your child is absent on a particular day and you have not contacted the school to explain why, the absence will be marked as unexplained.

This system also promotes daily school attendance. Going to school every day is the single most important part of your child's education, they learn new things every day – missing school puts them behind.

#### **GRADE 3-6 SWIMMING PROGRAM**

Dear Parents,

Children in Grades 3-6 will be participating in swimming activities at the Broadford Outdoor Pool for 5 weeks (start Tues 4th Feb -Fri 6th March) as part of their P.E. lessons.

This year there is **no cost for the lessons.** The school has received funding from the Education Department and Sporting Schools to cover this. At times, sessions may be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances. Please look below to see when your child will be swimming. They will need bathers, towel, goggles (if they own any) and sunscreen.

#### **Personal Property:**

#### **Insurance or Ambulance Cover:**

The Department does not provide personal accident insurance or ambulance cover for students. Parents and guardians of students, who do not have student accident insurance/ambulance cover, are responsible for paying the cost of medical treatment for injured students, including the cost of ambulance attendance/transport any other transport costs.


