Covid-19 Information Update

As everyone is well aware, the COVID-19 pandemic is creating challenging times for all communities. Routines and structure are great supports for our students in times of uncertainty. The current advice is that school is the best place for students to learn with the exception of where students are being kept out of school due to self-isolation requirements or based on medical advice.

As a school, we are following the advice of the Department of Education and implementing any new recommendations that are provided. Last night the Department announced the implementation of new cleaning procedures to include progressive cleaning throughout the day to ensure that risks of transmission are reduced. Social distancing will also be implemented where practical to limit direct contact. This includes non-contact greetings, some new seating arrangements in classrooms, lining up at the end of lunch and recess with increased space between students and cancelling our end of term assembly.

In addition to their normal planning, teachers are also currently preparing learning tasks for students in the event that we need to transition to remote learning in the future.

As a school we are committed to supporting our students and families in the current circumstances.
